

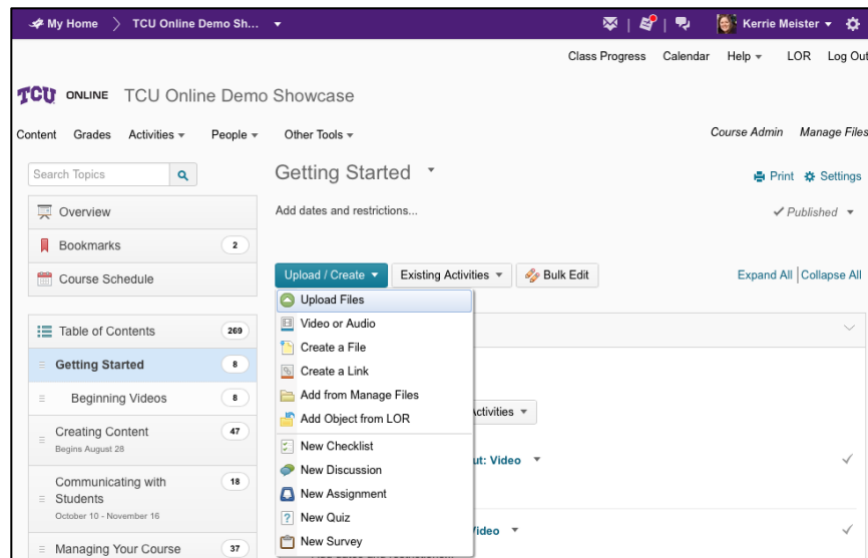
## The Daylight Experience in TCU Online

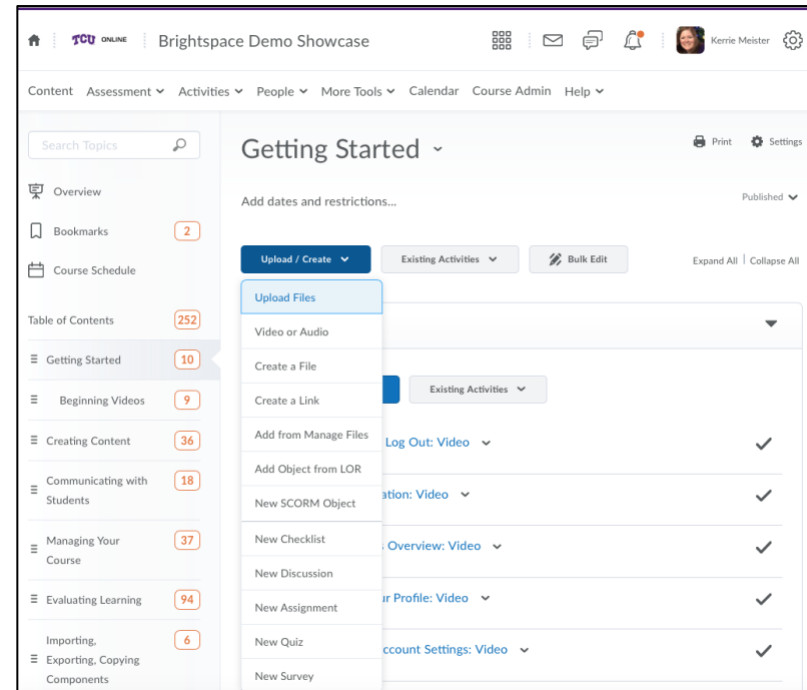
### Benefits of Daylight on Desktop

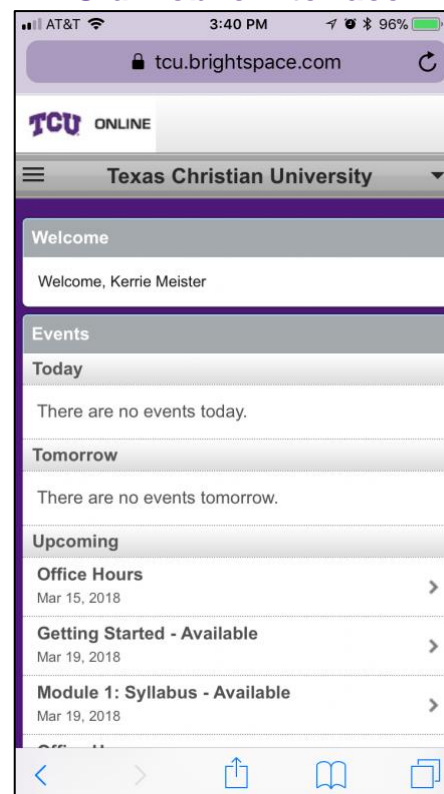
## Benefits of Daylight on Mobile

- **No functional changes** to any tools in TCU Online
- **Responsive design** – significantly improved mobile experience for all
- **New functionality**
  - Instructors can manage content
  - Students can submit to assignment submission folders
- Enhanced functionality
  - Students can more easily take quizzes
- Changes to look and feel, including:
  - Mirroring of desktop and mobile look, feel and navigation

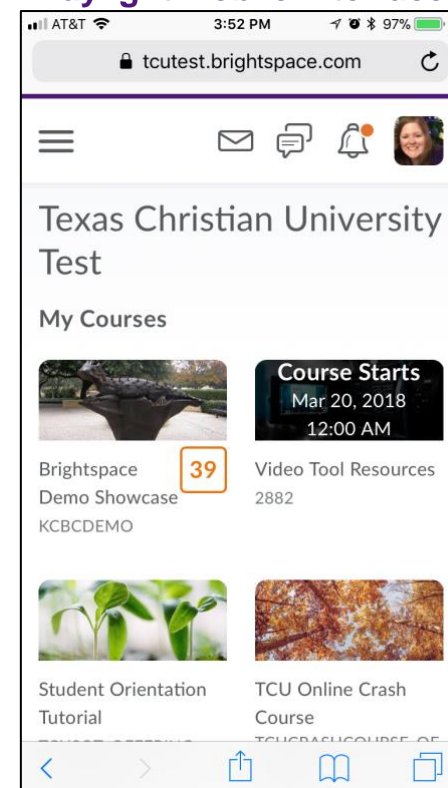
## Responsive Design

- Automatically resizes and scales for different sized screens, including mobile devices
- Allows students and faculty members to use a wider variety of devices
- Provides increased access to online materials for students without a personal computer or those that cannot commute to campus
- Much more accessible for students and faculty members with disabilities
